Our Speaker for May 18, 2009

Dr. Terrie Bert

Terrie brings many beautiful bromeliads to sell.

Don't miss them!

"Growing the Jewels of the New World"

In this presentation, she talks about the types of plants in 8 commonly grown bromeliad genera (Aechmea, Billbergia, Cryptanthus, Dyckia, Guzmania, Neoregelia, Tillandsia, Vriesea). For each genus, she reviews their natural distributions and habitats and growing conditions. Then she describe how they can be grown outdoors, give tips on their propagation, and provide information on how to deal with common bromeliad pests.

Background on Dr. Burt

Dr. Terrie Bert has been a member of the Sarasota Bromeliad Society since 1987 and of the Caloosahatchee Bromeliad Society since 1997 and has held multiple offices in the Sarasota Bromeliad Society. She served on the Florida Council of Bromeliad Societies for 9 years and was secretary, vice-president and president of the Council. She served on the Bromeliad Society International (BSI) Board of Directors for 7 years. She currently chairs the BSI Affiliated Shows Committee, is the BSI Librarian and curator of the Wally Berg Award of Excellence, and is a master judge. She's given over 80 presentations on bromeliads and bromeliad cultivation to numerous Florida bromeliad societies and other groups and has authored or coauthored 13 articles for bromeliad journals, including the BSI Journal. Her bromeliad collection consists of approximately 1,200 different types of bromeliads in 24 genera. She has won multiple top awards in the bromeliad shows of local clubs and in BSI world conferences. She is a volunteer for and contributor to the BSI Bromeliad Identification Center. In "real life," Terrie is a marine biologist for the state of Florida. She's led both the Genetics and Crustacean research programs. Currently, she's also president of the Sarasota Scuba Club.

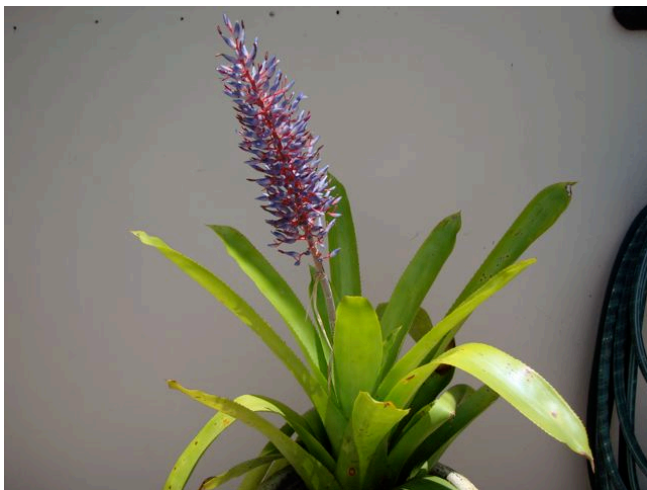
The Scurf has gone GREEN and your address is needed if you wish to receive your SCURF online. Saves postage as well especially with the increase in postage coming soon.



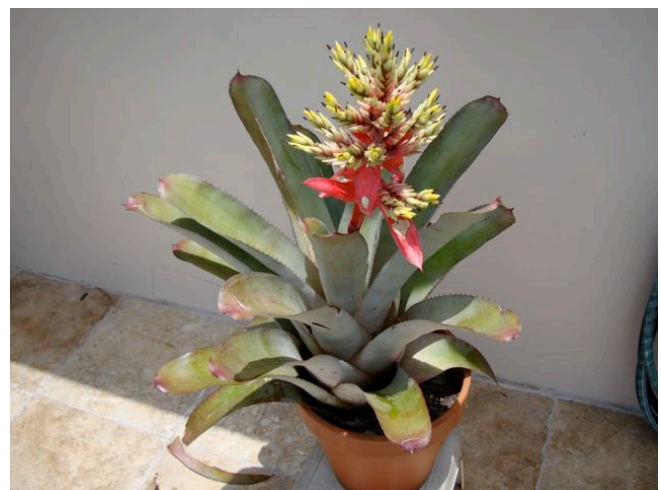

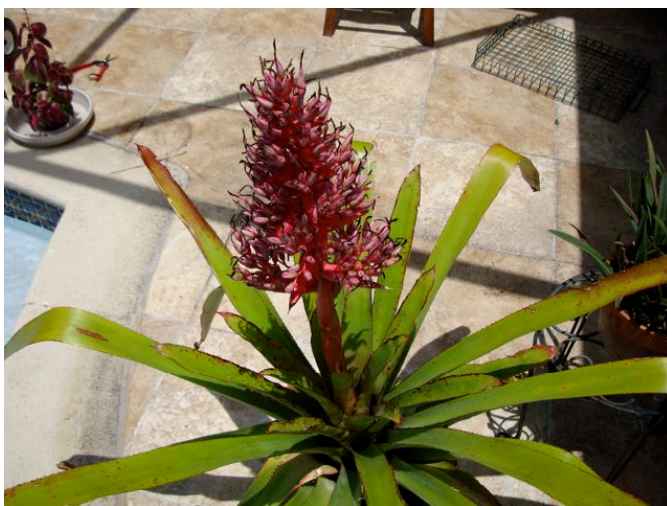

In the garden these plants are easy to grow and trouble free. It will grow in virtually any soil although they prefer free draining soil. They are completely resistant to salt spray and wind. They are surprisingly cold hardy - able to cope with several frosts in a season. Full sun produces best leaf color and form even with the green types. In tropical or sub-tropical climates some burning may occur in the middle of summer so mid-day shade is advisable. The plants tend to produce the best color in winter in these climates. In temperate climates burning is rare unless the plant has not been acclimatized before planting out.

FLORIDA JUDGES SCHOOL

The Florida Council of Bromeliad Societies is considering organizing a Judges school and is exploring the interest of all society members in the state.

The School consists of five sessions focusing on each of the main bromeliad genera and requires that 16 people are registered before it gets started. It lasts an average of 3 years with schools in various places, mostly in Fort Myers, one coinciding with a World Bromeliad Conference. In this case it would be the upcoming Conference in New Orleans. Each session will cost \$20.00(US). There will be a final exam before a judge is confirmed.
