**Selected with good growth, configuration and color.**

**Whether in a pot or mounted - very clean and with no scale.**

**In a pot proportional to the plant size.**

**Centered in a good clean pot with clean potting mix.**

**Properly identified - help is available if needed.**

PREPARING YOUR BROMELIADS FOR SHOW

All of you are invited to participate; especially those who have never won a blue ribbon or participated in a Bromeliad Show.

Your obligation will be supplying the entries.

The entries could be single plants; blooming or non blooming. They could be multiples that are interconnected, showing at least two mature plants. They also could be placed in a decorative container or in a mini arrangement not more than 4" high.

These entries should be clean and well groomed. No critters are invited. The entries will be critiqued by a panel of three B.S.I. Judges.

A first prize as well as a runner up will be awarded

Join in the fun as well as a learning process.

Names of those submitting the entries will not be released until all are judged.
