Our Speaker: Dr. Bruce McAlpin TIPS, TRICKS AND TECHNIQUES OF BROMELIAD CULTURE

Dr. McAlpin obtained his Masters and PhD in Botany and Plant Anatomy from Duke University in Durham, North Carolina. He taught Botany at a community college in Virginia for 1 1/2 years before taking a position at Wilson Botanical Gardens in Costa Rica. After a 3 year stay at Wilson Botanical Gardens, Dr. McAlpin moved on to the New York Botanical Gardens, where he remained for eight years. He subsequently took a position as Director of Horticulture at Selby Botanical Gardens, where he remained for three years. Dr. McAlpin taught Botany and Horticulture at Miami-Dade Community College for eighteen years before retiring.

He now lives in LaBelle, Florida and is an active member of the Caloosahatchee Bromeliad Society. In addition to growing bromeliads, he actively cultivates a host of other plants including palms, cycads, ferns, aroids and aquatic plants.

For those members new to bromeliad cultivation, Dr.McAlpine's talk will provide invaluable information regarding the "tips and tricks" of the professionals in the bromeliad world.
